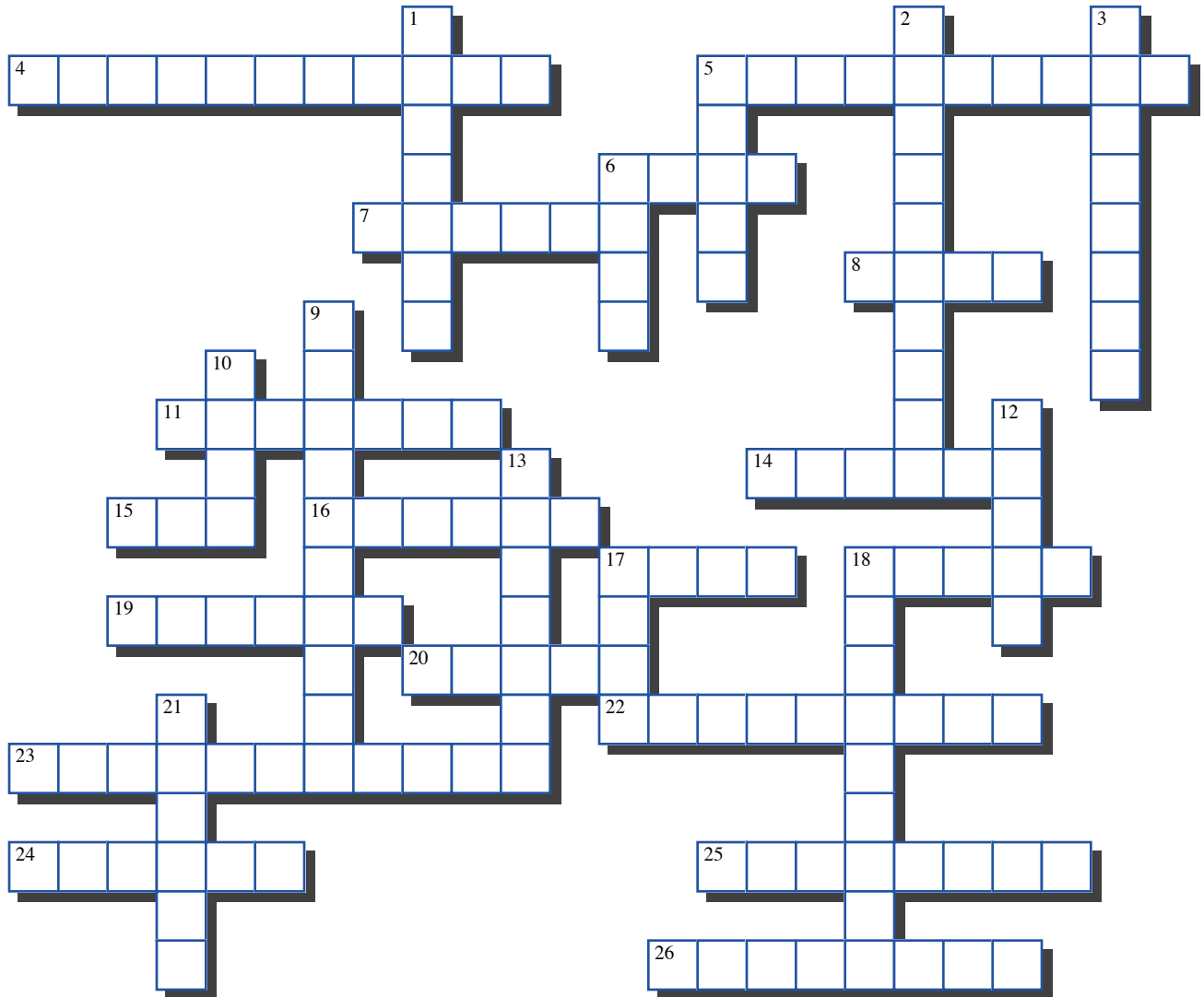


Pagan-01 Crossword Puzzle

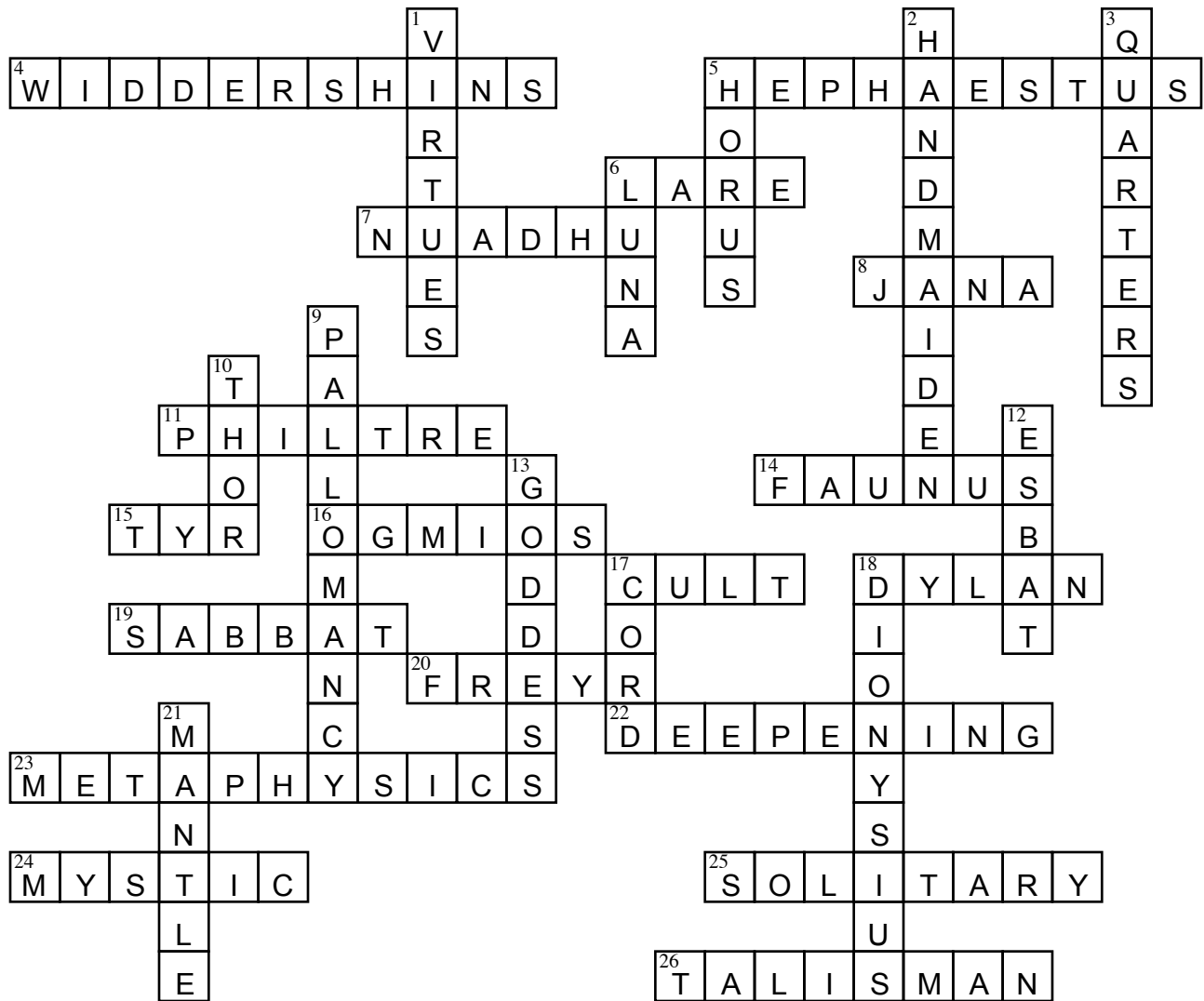
22. Reclaiming the dark; the fertile earth where the hidden seed lies unfolding. (9)
