| 3. DEEPENING    | ..... Reclaiming the dark; the fertile earth where the hidden seed lies unfolding.                              |
| 4. DIONYSIUS    | ..... God of religious ecstasy and wine, accompanied always by satyrs and nymphs.                               |
| 5. DYLAN        | ..... Celtic sea god.   |
| 6. ESBAT        | ..... Weekly or biweekly meeting of a coven. Traditionally held either on the full moon or the new moon.        |
| 7. FAUNUS       | ..... God of crops and herds. An oracle. His temple was where the she-wolf suckled romulus and remus.           |
| 8. FREYR        | ..... The god of the world, son of Njord, husband of Freyja.  |
| 9. GODDESS      | ..... 1. Supreme being of matriarchal avilizations. 2. An internal set of images and attitudes.                 |
| 10. HANDMAIDEN  | ..... The priestess assistant & replacement if the priestess cannot attend ritual/ perform her duties.          |
| 11. HEPHAESTUS  | ..... The lame blacksmith god, patron of craftsman and metalworkers, god of fire.                               |
| 12. HORUS       | ..... The falcon-headed god. A sky god whose eyes are the sun and the moon, continually at war with Set.        |
| 13. JANA        | ..... Italian moon goddess.   |
| 14. LARE        | ..... Ancestral spirits who are evolving within the spirit world.   |
| 15. LUNA        | ..... Roman goddess of the moon.  |
| 16. METAPHYSICS | ..... A field of abstract thought and philosophy about topics not on the concrete level of understanding.       |
| 17. MANTLE      | ..... A cloak worn by the celts whose color, fabric and condition was often an outward sign of rank in society. |
| 18. MYSTIC      | ..... One who has experienced god directly.   |
| 19. NUADHU      | ..... God of healing and water; his name suggests "wealth-bringer" and "cloud-maker."                           |
| 20. OGMIOS      | ..... Sun face. A hero god like Hercules, a god of eloquence, language, genius.                                 |
| 21. PALLOMANCY  | ..... Divination with a pendulum.   |
| 22. PHILTRE     | ..... A potion, especially for love.  |
| 23. QUARTERS    | ..... The north, east, south, and west parts of the circle, often representative of the four watchtowers.       |
| 24. SABBAT      | ..... One of the eight celebrations of paganism.  |
| 25. SOLITARY    | ..... A witch who practices alone instead of within a coven.  |
| 26. TALISMAN    | ..... An object being magickally charged in order to bring something to the bearer.                             |
| 27. THOR        | ..... God of thunder. Huge, red-bearded, red-eyed, powerful. His weapon is the magic hammer Mjollnir.           |
| 28. TYR         | ..... God of battle, the only god with the strength and courage to bind Fenris.                                 |
| 29. VIRTUES     | ..... Magickal properties of objects like herbs, stones, and creatures.   |
| 30. WIDDERSHINS | ..... Counter clockwise motion used in magick and ceremonies.   |
